

### **General information about the competition on transnational cooperation**

**Marshal's Office in łódzkie region** has announced open call for proposal for an innovative projects with a **transnational component** in the **Human Capital Operational Programme**. Projects should concern **Priority Axis "Regional human resources for the economy"** on the subjects:

1. Activities towards the extension of working age
2. Active labour market policy – looking for new, effective methods of vocational and social labour market activation in support of the target groups requiring special support (disabled people)

The estimate budget for projects is:

For subject 1 - is 5 500 000 PLN (approximately 1 375 000 Euros)

For subject 2 - is 7 0512 533 969 PLN (approximately 1 763 492 Euros).

The main purpose of the project is to elaborate, disseminate and implement innovative solutions pertaining to the extension of the working age of people over 50+ (subject1) and directed towards unemployed disabled people. In addition to subject 1 projects should aim at creating of mechanisms supporting possibility to implement qualifications' deficit and develop new skills as well as to introduce programs preparing of the target group for working life. For subject 2 projects should aim at vocational activating of disabled people taking into account the type of disability and possibility to include the environment in which the target group lives.

The scope of transnational cooperation is as follows: must be in line with the thematic scope of the project and cover all type of forms of cooperation, i.e.

- organisation of conferences, seminars, workshops and meetings,
- research and analysis activities,
- preparation, translation and publication of studies and reports,
- adaptation of solutions developed in another country,
- consulting, exchange of workers, placements and study visits,
- development of new solutions.
